Mr. Christensen:

Your current NRC license only authorizes your company to use portable gauges, it does not authorize to provide calibration services to other companies. To obtain authorization to provide calibration services to other companies, you need to submit a license amendment request to add this authorization following NUREG-1556, Volume 18 (service provider licensees). This will convert your license from portable gauge use only (program code 03121, fee code 3P) to a service provider license (program code 03225, fee code 3N). This change will increase your current annual fee. **For this fiscal year the portable gauge annual fee is \$4,800; while the service provider annual fee is \$14,300.**
