Dear Administrative Judges:

Pursuant to the Licensing Board's Memorandum and Order dated March 30, 2011, the Staff is providing the Licensing Board and the parties an index identifying additions to the Hearing File required to be disclosed by the Staff pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.336(d). Also in accordance with the March 30, 2011, Order, the Staff hereby updates the status of its schedule for issuing its review documents prepared in connection with the Application. The schedule has not changed since the last hearing file update. As indicated in the Staff letter to the Licensing Board dated November 3, 2011, the current schedule provides for completion of the advanced safety evaluation report (SER) with no open items in January 2013, completion of the final SER in November 2013, completion of the draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) in February 2013, and completion of the final EIS in February 2014.
