Enclosed please find five copies of the Final Exercise Report documenting the offsite emergency response capabilities demonstrated during the Indian Point Energy Center Plume Pathway Exercise conducted on November 14, 2006.

Based on the evaluation of the November 14, 2006 exercise by a team of Federal evaluators, New York State and local emergency response organizations adequately demonstrated their capabilities to implement appropriate radiological emergency response plans and preparedness procedures during a radiological emergency. Therefore, offsite emergency plans and preparedness remain adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken to protect the health and safety of the public living in the vicinity of the site in the event of a radiological incident occurring at the site.
