Reports are due no later than 30 days following the end of each reporting period. A final SF-425 is due within 90 days after expiration of the award. The report should be submitted electronically to: Grants\_FFR@NRC.GOV. (NOTE: There is an underscore between Grants and FFR)."

2) Revise PPR reports to <u>add</u> performance metrics, as follows: Under Attachment C – Standard Terms and Conditions; III. Programmatic Requirements; Performance (Technical) Reports is hereby revised to <u>add</u> the following:

## "Grant Performance Metrics:

In addition to the customary performance progress report requested on the SF-PPR, SF-PPR-B, and SF-PPR-E forms, NRC requires the following metrics to be reported on by the awardees as follows:

## **Fellowship Performance Metrics**

- 1. How many graduate students have been sponsored by NRC funding?
