SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MARCH 21-22, 2012, CLOSED MEETING WITH
WESTINGHOUSE ELECTRIC COMPANY TO DISCUSS FUEL
PERFORMANCE (TAC NO. ME7832)

On March 21-22, 2012, a closed meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff and representatives of Westinghouse Electric Company (Westinghouse) at the Westinghouse Office in Rockville, Maryland to discuss proprietary information regarding Westinghouse fuel performance and future plans.

The main topics of the discussions were High Burnup Program, Westinghouse Advanced Fuel Design, Spent Fuel Pool Criticality Analysis, and Pressurized Water Reactors, Boiling Water Reactors, and Advanced Boiling Water Reactors Topical Reports' submittals (current and future) and schedules, thermal conductivity degradation, and general licensing topics.
