SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED LICENSE RENEWAL FOR THE SMITH  
RANCH AND ASSOCIATED SATELLITE URANIUM RECOVERY FACILITIES

Dear Chairman Reider:

This letter is to notify you that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received an application from Power Resources, Inc., doing business as Cameco Resources, to renew its NRC source and byproduct license SUA-1548 for the Smith Ranch and associated remote satellite uranium in-situ recovery (ISR) facilities. The Smith Ranch ISR facility, which includes the Highlands Uranium Project and the Reynolds Ranch ISR satellite facility, is located in Converse County, Wyoming. Associated remote ISR satellite facilities included under License SUA-1548 and in the proposed license renewal are: (1) the Gas Hills ISR satellite facility in Fremont and Natrona Counties, Wyoming; (2) the North Butte ISR satellite facility in Campbell County, Wyoming; and (3) the Ruth ISR satellite facility in Johnson County, Wyoming. Enclosure 1 provides a map showing the general locations of the Smith Ranch facility and each of the remote ISR satellite facilities. Enclosure 2 is a list of potentially interested tribes.

NRC staff is providing this early notification to make you aware of this project and to provide you the opportunity to discuss this project and any concerns you may have. Please note that this letter does not constitute the initiation of the formal Section 106 Tribal Consultation process, as that process will start once the application is accepted for detailed review.
