Dear Mr. Wilson:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received your January 13, 2012, letter responding to my December 22, 2011, request for additional information on G4S Secure Solutions USA (G4S) "Special Operations Safeguards Information [SGI] Policy," G4S-SO SGI-001 (Revision 5).

On February 6, 2012, and March 26, 2012, NRC staff inspected the G4S remote offices located in Raeford, North Carolina and Omaha, Nebraska. The inspections included an examination of: (1) the security storage containers; (2) computer and peripheral equipment; (3) destruction equipment; (4) further review of the Policy; and (5) brief security related discussions with remote office personnel. As a direct result of the information obtained during the Raeford, North Carolina inspection and G4S responses to my request for additional information, a revised Policy (Revision 10) was forwarded to NRC for review and approval.

Based upon the NRC staff's inspection of the G4S remote offices and documented commitments for the day-to-day operating procedures in support of SGI safekeeping and storage requirements, the NRC staff has determined that G4S has met the regulatory requirements, as prescribed by Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* 73.21, for possession, handling and storage of SGI at its remote offices located in Raeford, North Carolina and Omaha, Nebraska.

Therefore, G4S may possess, handle, and store SGI at its remote offices located in Raeford, North Carolina, and Omaha, Nebraska. NRC approval for G4S possession and storage of SGI is limited to the aforementioned remote office locations. Request for consideration of additional facilities must be forwarded to NRC, and will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
