The purpose of this modification is to:

Revise the reporting requirement period for the Federal Financial Report (FFR, SF-425) to a semiannual basis, as follows: Under Attachment C – Standard Terms and Conditions; Monitoring and Reporting of this grant; "b. Federal Financial Reports" is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

b. Federal Financial Reports

The Grantee shall submit a "Federal Financial Report" (SF-425) on a semi-annual basis for the periods ending March 31 and September 30, or any portion thereof, unless otherwise specified in a special award condition. Reports are due no later than 30 days following the end of each reporting period. A final SF-425 is due within 90 days after expiration of the award. The report should be submitted electronically to: Grants_FFR@NRC.GOV. (NOTE: There is an underscore between Grants and FFR)."

2) Revise PPR reports to add performance metrics, as follows: Under Attachment C – Standard Terms and Conditions; III. Programmatic Requirements; Performance (Technical) Reports is hereby revised to add the following:

"Grant Performance Metrics:

In addition to the customary performance progress report requested on the SF-PPR, SF-PPR-B, and SF-PPR-E forms, NRC requires the following metrics to be reported on by the awardees as follows:

Faculty Development Performance Metrics

- 1. How many faculty have been sponsored by NRC funding?
 - a. Response is the number of faculty sponsored, for this reporting period and cumulative to the grant.
- 2. How many items have the sponsored faculty produced, for example, Professional Journal articles, publications, patents, or conference reports?
 - a. Response is the type and number of items, for this reporting period and cumulative to the grant."

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
