I contacted Mr. P. Madairy to clarify that they want to change the address on the current NRC License No. 29-28620-01 from Morristown, NJ to Ijamsville, MD, and to inform him that Smiths will have to submit an application for a new license. I explained that if Smiths Detection wants the address to be changed, the NRC would be required to terminate the current (or renewed) licensee and issue a new license with a new license number because the first two digits of the license number are state identifiers.

Mr. Madairy stated that he understood the process and he will discuss this with his contact at Smiths Detection. He feels that Smiths Detection will likely continue with the request to terminate License No. 29-28620-01 and submit a new license for the MD address.

I also discussed with Mr. Madairy the requirements of reciprocity. Mr. Madairy fully understands the requirements.

Also, Mr. Madairy stated that he called the general phone number for fees and had not yet received a reply. I informed him that I would locate a contact person and phone number and provide to him in an e-mail as soon as possible.
