SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATIONS (OI 4-2010-013 and 4-2011-018)

Dear Mr. Dietrich:

This refers to investigations conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations regarding activities at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station.

The Office of Investigations initiated Investigation 4-2010-013 to determine whether employees at Southern California Edison Company's San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, San Clemente, California, willfully failed to report to site management what they believed to be a plant modification and willfully failed to enter the incident into the corrective action program.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation that employees at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station willfully failed to report to site management what they believed to be plant modification was not substantiated.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation that employees at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station willfully failed to enter what they believed to be a plant modification event into the corrective action program was not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action related to the willful aspects of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.

The Office of Investigations initiated Investigation 4-2011-018 to determine whether a former contract electrical foreman at Southern California Edison Company's San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station was the subject of discrimination for raising safety concerns.


Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the alleged discrimination was determined to be not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action related to the discrimination aspect of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
