Total full-time equivalents (FTE)	<p>Enter the total number of full-time and part-time equivalents for each applicable activity under a function code. Therefore, all budgeted FTE should be included regardless of personnel status and whether the FTE is filled, vacant, on a non-reimbursable detail or on extended leave. First Year On Inventory	Applies only to commercial activities. Required by the Federal Activities Inventory Reform Act. Initial value was 1999. Enter the first year that the activity appeared on the inventory from the drop down listing. Use date from 2011 inventory, if applicable. Should be blank when activity is inherently governmental.
