Dear Mr. Satorius,

On November 1, 2010, Ur-Energy informed the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) by letter of its intent to submit a license amendment request for the Lost Soldier Project in March of 2012. With this letter, Ur-Energy wishes to inform the NRC that the amendment request for the Lost Soldier Project will not be submitted for agency review until at least the spring of 2013. Ur-Energy will keep the NRC abreast of any changes to this schedule.

The Lost Soldier Project is currently held by NFU Wyoming, LLC which, like Lost Creek ISR, LLC, is a 100% owned subsidiary of Ur-Energy USA Inc. The NRC Docket Number 40-9068 and Technical Assignment Control Number LU0142 were originally issued for both the Lost Creek and Lost Soldier Projects.
