I am on contract supporting the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) with the cultural resources review. My counterpart is Allison Travers at the NRC and I copied her on this email as well.

NRC published the Draft Final Environmental Statement related to the Operation of Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Unit 2, Supplement 2 in October 2011. Your office should have received a letter and the draft EIS for review and comment in November 2011.
