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## The purpose of this modification is to:

1) Revise the "Grant Performance Metrics" to include performance metrics. Under Attachment C – Standard Terms and Conditions; 2. Award Package – Grant Performance Metrics, deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

## "Grant Performance Metrics:

In addition to the customary performance progress report requested on the SF-PPR, SF-PPR-B, and SF-PPR-E forms, NRC requires the following metrics to be reported on by the awardees as follows:

- 1. Overall number of new courses developed in NRC designated STEM areas (including the names of the courses);
- 2. Number of students enrolled in new STEM courses;
- 3. Number of these enrolled students retained in STEM major."

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2) Revise the reporting requirement period for the Federal Financial Report (FFR, SF-425) to a semiannual basis. Under Attachment C – Standard Terms and Conditions; Monitoring and Reporting §215.51, "b. Federal Financial Reports" deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

## "b. Federal Financial Reports

The Grantee shall submit a "Federal Financial Report" (SF-425) on a semi-annual basis for the periods ending March 31 and September 30, or any portion thereof, unless otherwise specified in a special award condition. Reports are due no later than 30 days following the end of each reporting period. A final SF-425 is due within 90 days after expiration of the award. The report should be submitted electronically to: Grants\_FFR@NRC.GOV. (NOTE: There is an underscore between Grants and FFR)."

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged
