This is in reference to your application dated February 13, 2012 requesting Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 49-27460-02. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. To conduct operations at temporary job sites please provide a statement: "Licensed material will be used at temporary job sites anywhere in the United States where NRC maintains jurisdiction."
2. Please provide the copy of the RSO training certificate for Michael Nezworski.
3. Please confirm you will implement and maintain the operating, emergency and security procedures in Errata: Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Vol 1. Rev. 1, Dated November 2001, and provide copies of these procedures to all gauge users and at each job site.
4. Errata: Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Vol 1. Rev. 1 is attached to this e-mail for your convenience.

If we do not receive a reply from you by **May 11, 2012** we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your license request and the action will be voided without prejudice to the resubmission of a new license application.
