Subject: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dear Dr. Yelon:

This is in reference to your email dated April 17, 2012, requesting amendment to your U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Exempt Distribution License No. 24-32675-02E. We currently do not have sufficient information to complete the review of your amendment request. In order to continue our review we ask that you provide the following additional information:

The Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, Part 30, Section 30.34(b), states: "No license issued or granted pursuant to the regulations in this part and parts 31 through 36, and 39 nor any right under a license shall be transferred, assigned or in any manner disposed of, either voluntarily or involuntarily, directly or indirectly, through transfer of control of any license to any person, unless the Commission shall, after securing full information, find that the transfer is in accordance with the provisions of the Act and shall give its consent in writing." One implication of this requirement, as stated in section 5.6 of NUREG-1556, Volume 15, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Guidance About Changes of Control and About Bankruptcy Involving Byproduct, Source, or Special Nuclear Materials Licenses," is that the new licensee (transferee) must either (1) submit a commitment to abide by all constraints, license conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments identified in and attributed to the existing license; or (2) provide a description of its own program to comply with the license and all applicable regulations.

We note that Raphael Rechnitzer, Director, Topaz International Enterprises, LTD, in an email of February 9th, 2012, to a license reviewer in the NRC Region III office, stated: "...it is intended that ISQA operate under the same license and abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements and commitments previously in place." However, this commitment should be on the acquiring company's letterhead and should be signed by the appropriate legal representative of that company (presumably Mr. Rechnitzer).

In addition, please provide the exact company name and address that should appear on the license.

Any correspondence regarding this amendment application should reference the control number specified above.

If we do not receive your reply within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will consider your application as having been abandoned by you. This action would be without prejudice to the resubmission of another application with the required information.
