Subject: Status of the SER and Docketing of Revision Bs of the License Application

John,

This email serves to docket the status of the safety evaluation report (SER) for the International Isotopes Fluorine Products, Inc., (IIFP) license application review. As we have discussed via phone, the SER has received the Office of General Council's finding of no legal objection on Friday, April 13, 2012. The Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards is currently finalizing the administrative and managerial review of the document prior to publication, scheduled for May 2012.

Before the administrative review can be completed, the NRC must receive and docket the IIFP Revision B updates to the license application. Docketing the submittals in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) typically requires up to 2 weeks for processing. The NRC staff will work to finalize the SER in a timely manner once the IIFP updates have been docketed. Finalizing the IIFP documentation may impact the projected May 2012 completion date for the SER.

As you indicated via phone, the updates are in their final phase and will be submitted shortly.
