You recently issued amendment 71 to Materials Licensee 13-03284-02 (Reid Hospital and Health Care Services). The amendment approved a Dr. Harry Chong for 35.100 materials. As Dr. Chong is needed as an Authorized User for nuclear cardiology studies, the bulk of which are licensed under 35.200, it is hoped that you would be able to issue a corrected copy of amendment 71. In your cover letter, you stated you were not able to list Dr. Chong for 35.200 uses based on the information submitted. 12. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, individual(s) designated in writing:

13. Sealed sources shall be tested for leakage and/or contamination in accordance with OAC 3701:1-38-24.

14. All persons performing activities meeting the definition of "Nuclear Medicine Technologist" as specified in R.C. 4773.01 shall be licensed and in good standing with the state of Ohio.

15. In addition to the possession limits in Item 8, the licensee shall further restrict the possession of licensed material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in rule 3701:1-40-17 of the Ohio Administrative Code for establishing decommissioning financial assurance.

16. In accordance with the requirements in rule 3701:1-58-30 of the Ohio Administrative Code any patient administered gamma emitting radiopharmaceuticals or permanent brachytherapy sources shall be provided a patient release card to include:  
 (1) The patient's name.  
 (2) The radionuclide administered and its activity.  
 (3) The facility name which administered the radionuclide.  
 (4) The date of the administration of the radionuclide.  
 (5) The expiration date of the card.

The card is not applicable to those patients who are institutionalized (Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Correctional Institutions, etc.) or whose radiation levels do not exceed 0.1 mR/hr at one meter.

17. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents, including any enclosures, listed below. The Ohio Department of Health's statutes, rules, and orders shall govern unless statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.



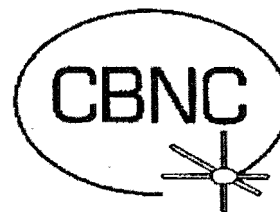
