**Subject:** Request for additional information regarding removal of 35.400 materials

Charlotte Hungerford Hospital had submitted a license amendment request to remove an authorized medical physicist and the use of 35.400 materials. I confirmed with Ms. Musser that they had only used Iodine-125 brachytherapy seeds. When the materials had been used, they were stored in the Nuclear Medicine hot lab. Since the hot lab is still in use, no close-out surveys are necessary. Ms. Musser stated that all seeds had been decayed-in-storage and disposed of as non-radioactive waste. There are currently no seeds in inventory or waste. The last seed patient was done on March 2, 2009. Since I-125 has a half life of 60 days, this confirms that all material would have been appropriately decayed.
