Subject: License Termination

Mr. Hankins called me to discuss terminating his NRC license. He stated that he has not had any material stored in Puerto Rico since 2009 and that all material was transferred to a State of Texas license. I told him we needed to have the NRC certificate of disposition of materials form submitted to us along with survey/leak test data that there was no leaking sources/contamination at the storage location in Puerto Rico. He stated he would get on this tomorrow (Thursday).

He further stated that although he transferred the material to the Texas licensee, he did not authorize the use of the company name. He is currently in litigation over the use of the name "Caribbean Inspection & NDT Services". I reminded him that the two licenses were separate and therefore his NRC license termination was independent of the ability for the entity in Texas to operate under their Texas license.

He stated that he was traveling today and would get to work on the form tomorrow.

I thanked him for his time and ended the call.

NOTE: Due to the fact that there has not been any material stored in Puerto Rico since the last inspection and the impending termination of his license, there is no need to conduct an onsite inspection at this time. This telephone record will also serve as the start of the inspection.
