Dear Mr. Shear:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 03 to your NRC Material License No. 24-32539-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please note that Subitem 9.A has been revised to exclude Troxler Electronics Labs, Inc. Model 4300 Series because this model can only be used with Americium-241 sealed sources in accordance with the SDR registry. We have also removed Condition 11.B with regard to the future RSO. Please note that you must request and obtain a license amendment before you change the RSO. In addition, we have removed Condition 18 of your license with regard to the decommissioning financial assurance requirement. Based on your total possession limit, this condition is not applicable to your program.

Additionally, we have revised Condition 13 to include Subitem F regarding the leak test records. We have also revised Condition 18 regarding the provisions for securing of the portable gauges. These changes appear in **bold font**.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any questions or errors, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate answers and corrections.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
