Mr. Bunker,

The FRN is associated with the NRC adjudicatory process which is separate from NRC Staff review of the Ross project.

During NRC's review of a license application, the public is afforded an opportunity to participate through a hearing process. A public member can request to participate by submitting a 'request to intervene'. After the request is filed, a board of three independent judges is set up to evaluate the merits of the request. In the case of the Ross Project, the board agreed that the interveners had standing to participate. However, NRC staff and the applicant appealed the decision of the board to the NRC Commissioners. The FRN includes the formal voting of the Commissioners on the appeal. NRC staff is not involved with the FRN nor developing a distribution list for such actions.

I am the project manager for the Safety review of the Ross Project. I will note your interest in the project and will try to keep you abreast of actions on this project that fall under Staff's review.
