SUBJECT: TWO IDENTICAL VERSIONS OF LICENSE APPLICATION  
XSOU8828 WITH DIFFERENT SIGNATURE DATES

Mr. John Eves from Global Advanced Metals USA, Inc. called on April 16, 2012 to inquire about the status of the license application they had submitted in February 2012. However, the OIP licensing database showed no record of receiving/accepting the application. The applicant then emailed a copy of the application, which was signed on February 14, 2012, for ECIO staff to review. Through the MATU spreadsheet, the staff was able to identify the processing fee for \$2700.00 being deposited by the NRC/NBC on February 24, 2012. The staff immediately reviewed and released the emailed copy of the application, dated February 14, 2012 to the public, and asked the applicant to submit an original signed version. On April 18, 2012 the staff received the identical application with the original signature, but dated on April 17, 2012, rather than February 14, 2012. Thus, except for the two different signature dates, there are two identical versions of license application XSOU8828.

Since the license applications are identical except for the signature dates, I recommend that OIP does not retrieve or revise what has been released in ADAMS at this time.
