NRC STAFF PROPOSED PARTIAL INITIAL DECISION
FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
ON CONTENTION 10C

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff (Staff) hereby files this Errata to the “NRC Staff’s Proposed Partial Initial Decision, Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law on Contention 10C” filed April 20, 2012, to correct errors in the filing.¹ Each correction is identified below. These corrections do not alter NRC Staff’s testimony, exhibits or conclusions in the NRC Staff’s Proposed Findings.

Staff makes the following corrections.

On page 19, paragraph number 73, as written reads:

Applicants’ Witness Ratti testified that he expected approximately 21 MW of wind power capacity to come on line in Maryland over the next few years. *Id.* at A37. Applicants’ Witness Ratti testified that even under optimistic (though speculative) conditions, up to 100 MW is possible. *Id.* at A38.

It should be corrected to read:

Applicants' Witness Ratti testified that he expected approximately ~~24-70~~ MW of wind power capacity to come on line in Maryland over the next few years, equivalent to an average output of about 21 MW. *Id.* at A37. Applicants' Witness Ratti testified that even under optimistic (though speculative) conditions, up to 100 MW is possible. *Id.* at A38.

On page 33, paragraph 119, the first sentence as written reads:

This Board finds that the FEIS need only discuss those alternatives that will bring about the ends of the proposed action – a large baseload facility in the region of interest.

It should be corrected to read:

This Board finds that the FEIS need only discuss those alternatives that will bring about the ends of the proposed action – a large baseload facility electrical generating capacity in the region of interest.

On page 38, paragraph 138, as written reads:

Applicants' Witness Ratti testified that he expects approximately 21 MW of wind power capacity to come on line in the next few years and that under optimistic (though speculative) conditions, up to 100 MW is possible. Applicants' Direct Testimony at A37 (Exhibit APL000001).

It should be corrected to read:

Applicants' Witness Ratti testified that he expects approximately ~~24~~ 70 MW of wind power capacity to come on line in the next few years, equivalent to an average output of about 21 MW, and that under optimistic (though speculative) conditions, up to 100 MW of average output is possible. Applicants' Direct Testimony at A37 (Exhibit APL000001).

On page 38, paragraph 141, the first two sentences as written read:

The FEIS presents a well reasoned explanation for examining a combination alternative of 100 MW wind and 75 MW solar with a natural gas contribution of 1475 MW. While the Joint Intervenors testified at length about the theoretical potential of wind and solar, they failed to identify any wind or solar projects that were likely to come on line before 2017, or any projects that would supply more than the 175 MW identified in the FEIS.

The sentences should be corrected to read:

The FEIS presents a well reasoned explanation for examining a combination alternative of 100 MW wind and 75 MW solar with a natural gas contribution of ~~4475~~1200 MW. While the Joint Intervenors testified at length about the theoretical potential of wind and solar, they failed to identify any wind or solar projects that were likely to come on line before 2017, ~~or any projects~~ that would supply more than the 175 MW identified in the FEIS.
