## Goals

- **Regulatory Stability**
  - **Consistency with other risk-informed applications**
  - **Consistent process for identification of 'generic issues'**
  - **Establish a consistent level of detail for information needed to generate the safety evaluation**
  - **Reduce the number of RAIs and increase the efficiency of the review process**

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## Industry Concerns

- **Expanding list of generic questions being identified despite pilot process and mutually established templates**
- **Treatment of NFPA 805 risk-informed submittal is different than other risk-informed submittals**
  - **Level of detail, e.g., fire PRA, fire modeling**
  - **Sensitivity study expectations**

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## Industry Concerns (cont'd)

- **Acceptable content/level of detail to support safety evaluation lacks clarity and stability**
- **Concern that generic RAIs could become part of the LIC-109 acceptance review**

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## Potential Solutions

- **Discuss management of generic RAI topics monthly**
  - Meeting summaries to document closure
- **Obtain agreement on proposed resolutions, such as:**
  - Address via LAR/SE template.
  - NRC reviews topic as part of the background document review, but no RAI needed.
  - NRC issues RAI, but not included in LAR submittal.
  - Determine that the information is beyond that necessary for SE

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## Potential Solutions

- **Use FAQs for select major topics.**
- **Monitor process during management meetings (effectiveness, consistency expectations).**

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## Path Forward

- **Use 6/27/12 Non-Pilot Meeting to discuss specific examples and solutions.**
- **Industry/NRC work to manage timely resolution of generic topics.**

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
