NRC MEETING JUNE 13, 2012, IN CLINTON, ILLINOIS, TO DISCUSS PROPOSED PARTIAL SITE RELEASE OF CLINTON POWER STATION, UNIT 1

Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will conduct a public meeting in Clinton, Illinois, on Wednesday, June 13, 2012, to discuss Exelon Generation Company's proposed release of a portion of its Clinton Power Station, Unit 1 site for unrestricted use.

The NRC is reviewing plans by Exelon to release the 4-acre area located across Lake Clinton, to Creek Township to expand Lisenby Cemetery. The agency will only authorize the release if it poses no threat to public health and safety.

The NRC will hold the meeting at the Vespasian Warner Public Library District, 310 N. Quincy St., Clinton, Il, from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. NRC staff presentations will describe the overall process for partial site releases and the status of the staff review. The public will also have the opportunity to comment on the proposal.

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) is considering the request for partial site release to Facility Operating License No. NPF-62 issued to Exelon Generation Company, LLC (the licensee, EGC) for operation of the Clinton Power Station, Unit 1 (CPS), located in DeWitt County, Illinois.

The proposed partial site release would transfer 4-acres of property, owned by EGC, from CPS to Creek Township to expand the Lisenby Cemetery.

Before acceptance of the partial site release, the Commission will have made findings required by the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's regulations.

The Commission is seeking public comments on this proposed determination. Any comments received on or before June 13, 2012 will be considered in making any final determination.
