As a concerned citizen, I'd like to voice my support and endorsement of the Nuclear Information and Resource Service's three-tiered Emergency Planning Zone. I hope you will seriously consider them too. As per their recommendations, this includes the following:

The current 10-mile zone would expand to 25 miles, with all current requirements intact. A new zone from 25-50 miles would be established; utilities would be required to notify residents of these zones of evacuation routes if needed, but would not conduct biannual exercises. The Ingestion Pathway Zone, designed for interdiction of contaminated food, milk, and water, would be expanded from the current 50 miles to 100 miles. And a new rule would be established that would require emergency exercises to include scenarios of initiating or concurrent regionally-appropriate natural disasters.
