As a result of the disastrous situation in Japan after the tsunami and the collapse of the nuclear power plants, we should have learned what to do in the U.S. when and if we have a similar catastrophe. Restrictions and food and water testing should at the same time begin in the 25 to 50 mile radius. Details need to be worked out by those in charge. They need to be planned now, so they will be of use in an emergency situation.
