Dear NRC License Review Section:

Saint Luke's Hospital of Chillicothe d/b/a Hedrick Medical Center (HMC) is requesting that your office terminate its radioactive materials license. HMC is now administered by Saint Luke's Hospital of Kansas City (SLH). SLH is participating in an effort to incorporate affiliated hospitals/clinics within the Saint Luke's Health System (SLHS) radiation safety program. We therefore request that our activities be placed under Saint Luke's Hospital of Kansas City's Type A License of Broad Scope (License No. 24-00889-01, Docket No. 030-02286/030-34167/030-33080). In an attempt to standardize and provide better radiation safety services across the Saint Luke's Healthcare System, we intend to systemize policies, procedures and services under a System Radiation Safety Officer. Details of this program are provided in the SLH renewal which includes a request to incorporate HMC license activities under the broad scope license. We have enclosed NRC Form 314 to officially request this termination. Saint Luke's administration continues to provide its strongest backing to fulfill its materials license commitments. 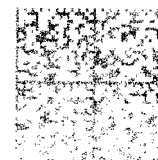
