As someone who lives within 2 miles of the Seabrook Nuclear Station, I am in a constant state of alert as to the status of that plant.

In the summer, we have well over 100,000 people half-dressed on the NH beaches due east/northeast of this plant. The roads in and out of the area are single-lane, small town roads.

I also wonder about the 8 schools located within 3miles of that plant and our ability to react early enough to get those hundreds nad thousands of children out of harms way.

This technology makes no sense. People and radiation don't mix. A SERIOUS review of evacuation issues would make the NRC have to close plants. THAT is the reality of taking your job seriously. Oh, but wait, if there are no nuclear plants than what do you have to regulate???
