

CERTIFICATE OF VOTE

I, MARY LOU MURZYN, Town Clerk of Kingston, do hereby certify that the following is a true and exact copy of the final vote on Article 33 as contained in the Minutes of the Annual Town Meeting duly called and held on April 9, 2012, April 10, 2012, and April 11, 2012, which vote was taken on April 11, 2012:

Article 33. On the motion of Sara Altherr, VOTED that the Town of Kingston, MA, opposes continued operation of Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station (PNPS) until all safety improvements recommended by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) as a result of lessons learned from failures of similarly designed reactors in Fukushima, Japan, have been fully implemented and requests the NRC to immediately suspend all further action on the application of the Entergy Corporation for renewal of its license to operate PNPS until such full implementation has been accomplished. The clerk of Kingston shall forward the text of this article to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, the Town of Kingston's State and Federal delegations, the Select Boards within the Emergency Planning Zone of the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station, and Entergy Corporation, so that the intent of the citizens of Kingston is widely known. 
