Called the applicant to discuss the license application, the use of the device, and the option to have the device distributed via the general license (GL) provisions of 10 CFR 31.5. The applicant stated that the device is a fixed gauge to be used on natural gas hydraulic fracturing sites. The gauge will be attached to piping and used to measure density of fracturing fluids. The device will not be used as a well logging tool. No down-hole use of this device. I informed the applicant that the Sealed Source and Device Evaluation allowed for the device to be distributed under GL provisions. I explained that the GL provisions require the device to be registered with NRC, however, the registration fee is significantly less than a specific license fee for the same device. I also explained that the requirements of 10 CFR 31.5 must be adhered to as condition of possession of the device. Mr. Wells said he understood and that he would speak to his management about acquiring the device under the GL provisions. I advised the applicant to contact me when a decision had been made. The applicant said he believed there was a misunderstanding when he first discussed US Well Services need to acquire the device, and that he was initially advised to submit an application for a specific license for the device. I apologized for any misunderstanding and discussed the potential cost savings to be gained by acquiring the gauge under GL. Mr. Wells thanked me and said he would call back to discuss the matter further.
