PURPOSE: The purpose of the meeting is for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Augmented Inspection Team (AIT) to provide a status of their recent inspection following the Unit 3 steam generator tube leak on January 31, 2012, with Southern California Edison Company.

CATEGORY: This is a Category 1 meeting. During the meeting, which is open to public observation, the NRC staff will provide a summary of the Augmented Inspection Team's observations thus far, followed by a response from the licensee. After a short break, the NRC staff will be available to answer questions from the public and accept comments on issues related to San Onofre. This will be the first in a series of public meetings to be held in the area to keep the public informed on the progress of NRC inspection and oversight activities at San Onofre.
