In the renewal application, the licensee requested isotopes not previously authorized on the license. The requested isotopes would have required financial assurance in the amount of \$225,000. I contacted Mr. Reif to determine if the licensee in fact wanted the additional isotopes. I also stated that the Letter of Credit the licensee submitted as the financial assurance instrument was incomplete and was actually addressed to The State of Massachusetts. I informed Mr. Reif that if he did wish to pursue the requested isotopes and possession limits that he should review NUREG1757 Volume 3 Appendix A which gives examples financial assurance instruments acceptable to the NRC. I also explained that the licensee may want to consider the isotopes and quantities that are actually being used on the research vessels (that NRC has jurisdiction over) to determine what they will actually need to request. Mr. Reif asked, if he could retract the original request and continue to use what is currently on the license. I stated that if the licensee decides that the current authorizations are sufficient to meet their needs, then he could send a letter to state that he no longer wished to request the list in the renewal application and will maintain the current authorizations. Mr. Reif stated that he will make a decision on whether to keep the current material authorizations as listed on the license or supply the appropriate financial assurance and keep the request. I also asked for a letter for Delegation of Authority for the RSO from management. He stated he would send the information requested via fax.
