Dear Mr. Busch:

By application dated March 30, 2012, Taylor Engineering, Inc. informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of the intention to terminate NRC radioactive materials license 46-29250-01. You stated that all radioactive material was transferred to your Washington State Radioactive Material License WN-I0293-1 and provided the leak test results showing no leakage had occurred at the time of the transfer. In accordance with 10 CFR 20.1402 the facility located at 2410 Longhorn Court, Post Falls, Idaho is released for unrestricted use.

Please find enclosed Amendment Number 04 to License Number 46-29250-01, authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(ii).
