**SUPPLEMENT TO 2.206 ENFORCEMENT PETITION REGARDING LABOR
DISPUTE- PILGRIM NPS (SUBMITTED MAY 16, 2012)**

Pilgrim Watch and other organizations submitted a 2.206 on May 16 regarding the labor dispute at Pilgrim Station highlighting its public safety implications. PW wishes on behalf of the Petitioners to supplement the petition with a focus on the currently unsafe operations of Pilgrim.

We request that the reactor is shut down until the labor dispute is resolved. We believe, and know, that operation with replacement workers is a serious threat to public health and safety, not to mention further decreasing any remaining public confidence in NRC as a regulator. Absent documented evidence that the replacement workers have received extensive hands-on training onsite on both operations and emergency response plans at Pilgrim; and absent sufficient staffing so that required worker's hours are followed so that workers are alert and not sleeping on the floor (as the attached photos show) there is no reasonable assurance that public health and safety are being protected. Show us the numbers- the documentation - of the precise training, staffing, and scheduling hours. We do not accept or should be expected to accept "trust us."

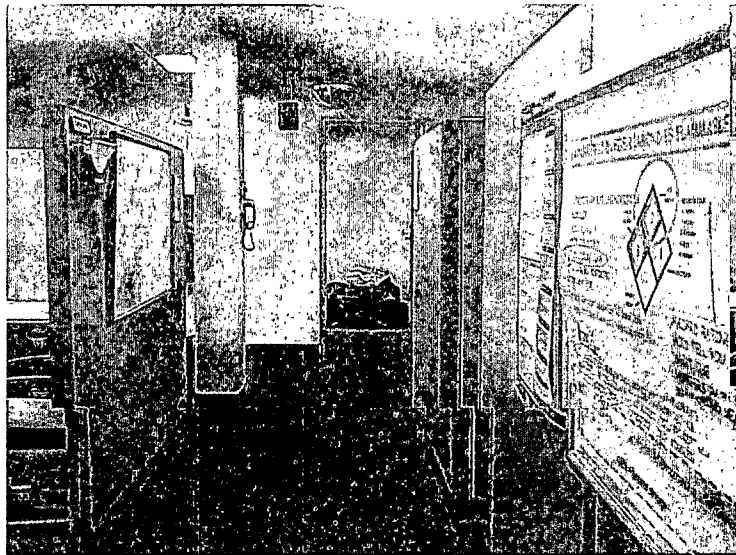
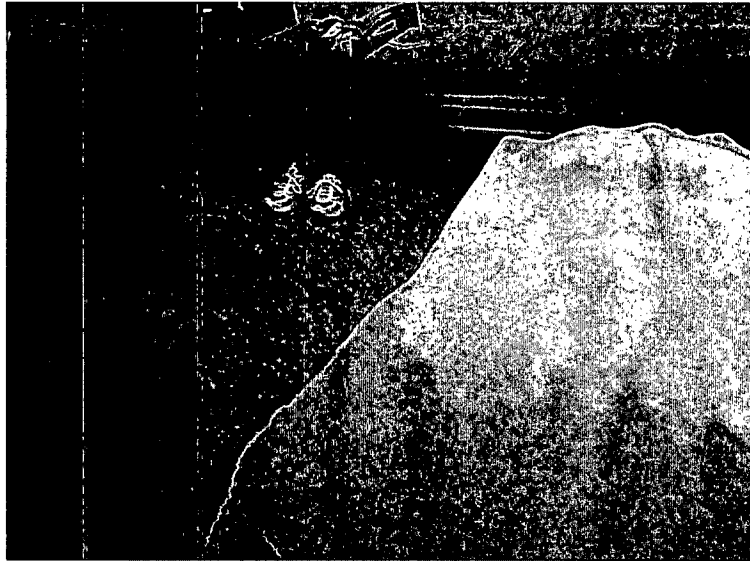
