On May 16, 2012, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security baseline inspection at your San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3. The enclosed inspection report documents the inspection results, which were discussed on May 16, 2012, with Mr. Doug Bauder, Vice President and Station Manager, and other members of your staff.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

The attached report documents one finding that has preliminarily been determined to be Greater than Green (i.e., finding of greater than very low security significance) that may result in the need for further evaluation to determine the significance and, therefore, the need for additional

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
