Subject: Reply to a Notice of Violation

Professional Service Industries, Inc. (PSI) is in receipt of your letter dated March 27, 2001, regarding the January 17, 22 and 23, 2001 inspections of activities under the authorization of NRC Radioactive Materials (RAM) License Number 12-16941-01. PSI provides the following in response:

- A. In the past, PSI had suggested that the door would serve as an emergency exit in case of an accident. The door was not used as the primary means of entrance or egress for the radiography area.

Since the time of the inspection PSI has had the entrance fitted with the required audible warning signal.

Compliance is considered immediate.

- B. As noted in your correspondence, PSI identified an occurrence where radiography had been performed that may have been outside the stipulations set forth in NRC Information Notice 99-22. After recognition of the possible infraction, PSI took the appropriate actions to ensure that any future performance of radiography would be conducted in accordance with the appropriate regulations.

Compliance is considered immediate.
