On May 7, 2012, an Order Revoking License was issued to Pyrotec, Inc. for nonpayment of fee for License Number NR-0554-D-101-E, Invoice Number LFB 11-5284. Since 30 days has elapsed, action on the Order is as indicated below:

- License revoked for nonpayment of fee effective N/A. All requirements of the Order are effective and should be confirmed. The License Fee Team has entered Status Code 5 in the License Tracking System to indicate the license is revoked for nonpayment of fees. Future applications from the licensee should not be processed until all debts are resolved. The debt will be referred to the Department of the Treasury for collection. Regions should change the primary program code to the appropriate possession program code, and the old code should become the secondary code. Also change the flag for "storage only" to yes.
- Licensee paid invoice in full; therefore the Order Revoking License is not in effect.
- Licensee submitted "Good Cause" therefore the Order Revoking License is not in effect. Future applications from the licensee, however, should not be processed until all debts are resolved. The debt will be referred to NRC's debt collection contractor as appropriate.
- Licensee requested a hearing. Request was forwarded to OGC on N/A.
- Other: Certified receipt unclaimed; therefore, the Order Revoking License is not in effect.
