LICENSEE: <p>The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 1. Based on the inspection findings, no violations were identified.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 2. The violation(s), specifically described to you by the inspector as non-cited violations, are not being cited because they were self-identified, non-repetitive, and corrective action was or is being taken, and the remaining criteria in the NRC Enforcement Policy, to exercise discretion, were satisfied.</p> <p><u>1</u> Non-Cited Violation(s) was/were discussed involving the following requirement(s) and Corrective Action(s): Condition 27 on the license states that the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents listed in that condition. Transmitted as an enclosure in the letter dated December 27, 2004, AFRRI Instruction 6055.8E: Radiation Protection Program states that the Radionuclide and X-Ray Safety Committee (RXSC) "...shall oversee and approve through the Safety and Health Department (SHD) the procurement, use, and disposal of all ionizing radiation sources..."</p> <p>Contrary to the above, on October 13, 2011 an Electron Capture Detector (ECD) containing 15mCi of Nickel-63 was brought to the AFRRI facility by an AFRRI staff member. The staff member ordered the device under the USUHS ordering system but did not inform the AFRRI RSO. The ECD was installed into a gas chromatograph by the manufacturer. The RSO for the AFRRI license discovered the source was at the AFRRI facility when she contacted the alternate RSO for USUHS regarding an e-mail sent in October 2011. The licensee informed the NRC in a letter dated February 23, 2012 of the potential violation. The AFRRI RSO requested and was given the leak test certificate for the ECD. The source was then assigned a unique number on the AFRRI inventory list and the RSO was assigned as source custodian. In addition, the staff member and all AFRRI personnel were trained and made aware of the requirement to inform the RSO of any radioactive material brought onto the AFRRI site. During the time of the inspection, the ECD was listed on the inventory.</p> <p>This is a non-cited violation because the licensee identified and reported it to the NRC and performed corrective actions.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 4. During this inspection, certain of your activities, as described below and/or attached, were in violation of NRC requirements and are being cited in accordance with NRC Enforcement Policy.
