To the Commissioners:

I am writing on behalf of the San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace, an all-volunteer, non-profit organization based in California, adjacent to Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. The group has been the legal intervenor since 1973 concerning construction, licensing, and operation of the Diablo Canyon facility.

In the aftermath of the disaster in Fukushima, opposition to the use of nuclear energy has grown. Enclosed are 405 signatures of people who are demanding that both California nuclear facilities – Diablo Canyon and San Onofre – be shut down immediately and permanently.

Problems with nuclear power abound: storage of nuclear waste, seismic hazards, emergency response, vulnerability to terrorism, and aging components.


