This is in reference to your application dated June 8, 2012, requesting a renewal to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License 11-29245-01. When submitting a renewal, you must provide a complete application. We cannot process the renewal application as received. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Please resubmit your renewal request by following the guidance in NUREG 1556 Volume 2 "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program – Specific Guidance About Industrial Radiography License" (attached). Specifically, the guidance found in Chapter 8 and Appendix C will be helpful in the preparation of your renewal application.

If we do not receive a response by the due date, we will assume you do not wish to continue with the license renewal application and this action will be voided without prejudice to the resubmission of a new license request.
