The purpose of this letter is to provide an update on the status of the Calvert Cliffs 3 Nuclear Project, LLC ("CC3") desalination plant construction and the availability of water for use by Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, LLC ("CC1/2"), as required per the Calvert Cliffs Unit 3 Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) (Reference 1) Condition 37.

The availability of water and parameters as presented formally to CC1/2 in 2009, Reference 2, has not changed. Although a detailed CC3 construction schedule has not yet been fully developed, it is the intent of the project to build and operate the desalination plant as described in the Combined License Application (COLA) submitted to the NRC and as described in the CPCN, Reference 1. The desalination plant construction is expected to take approximately one year and will be operational in time to support the startup and commissioning of CC3.
