Subject: Detroit Edison's 120-day Response to March 12, 2012
Information Request Regarding Seismic Walkdowns

On March 12, 2012, the NRC issued Reference 2 to all power reactor licensees and holders of construction permits in active or deferred status. Enclosure 3 of Reference 2 contains specific Requested Actions, Requested Information and Required Responses associated with Recommendation 2.3, Seismic.

Enclosure 3 of Reference 2 states that each addressee, within 120 days of the date of the information request, will confirm that they intend to use the NRC-endorsed seismic walkdown procedures or provide to the NRC a description of the process that will be used to conduct the walkdowns and to develop the needed information.

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Detroit Edison confirms that it intends to use the seismic walkdown procedure in Reference 3 to conduct the walkdowns and develop the needed information at Fermi 2. Reference 3 is the final version of the draft document endorsed by the NRC in Reference 4.

This letter contains no new regulatory commitments.
