On March 12, 2012, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Reference (1) to NextEra Energy Point Beach, LLC (NextEra). Enclosure 3 of Reference (1) contains specific Requested Actions, Requested Information, and Required Responses associated with Recommendation 2.3 for Seismic Walkdowns. This letter provides NextEra's 120-day response to Reference (1) for Seismic Recommendation 2.3 for Point Beach Nuclear Plant (PBNP).

For Seismic Recommendation 2.3 (Walkdowns), Enclosure 3 of Reference (1) states that each licensee will confirm that they intend to use the NRC-endorsed seismic walkdown procedure or provide to the NRC a description of the process that will be used to conduct the walkdowns and develop the needed information.

NextEra confirms that it will use the seismic walkdown guidance (EPRI 1025286, "Seismic Walkdown Guidance: For Resolution of Fukushima Near-Term Task Force Recommendation 2.3: Seismic"), as endorsed by Reference (2), to conduct the Seismic Walkdowns and develop the needed information at PBNP.

This letter contains no new Regulatory Commitments and no revisions to existing Regulatory Commitments.
