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SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI), Region II (RII), on August 22, 2011, to determine whether an engineer willfully falsified surveillance tests concerning the Harris Nuclear Plant (HNP), Emergency Operations Facility (EOF).
