Cardinal Health 414, LLC on behalf of Borschow Hospital & Medical Supplies, Inc., a Cardinal Health company, (hereafter Cardinal Health) submits additional information in response to the July 13, 2012 e-mail request from Steven Courtemanche with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Region I. The general wording of the request is in italics followed by the Cardinal Health response.

The NRC requires a letter signed by senior management indicating the reason for the request to void the action. In your case, you were not able to supply all of the information requested in the NRC's June 12, 2012, Request for Additional Information letter within the time frame set by the NRC. The information needed included the names and qualifications of individuals who were to fill positions in the pharmacy and a copy of the pharmacy license issued by the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.

Cardinal Health requests that our application for the above license number, mail control number 577398 be voided without prejudice until such time that the information requested is available and provided with regard to the above referenced license application and NRC mail control number 577398. Our previous response to your letter dated June 12, 2012 was dated June 26, 2012. As explained in our call today with Mr. Courtemanche, this is to explain that when the Broschow nuclear pharmacy facility staffing is completed, Cardinal Health will provide the names and qualifications of individuals who are to fill positions in the pharmacy and a copy of the Puerto Rico pharmacy license.

We require more time to submit all of the information requested in the letter dated June 12, 2012. Cardinal Health does not have access to internal NRC policies and procedures, however, we understand the review process described in NUREG-1556,




