This refers to your license amendment request. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license. This license amendment changes your authorized use location to your facilities located at Route 61, McClellan Mountain Road, Kincaid, WV, and changes your radiation safety officer to Mr. Rick Simpkins. In addition, because you did not possess specifically licensed materials at your Hughes Creek Terminal, Highway 60, Hughes Creek Road, Hughes Creek, West Virginia facility, that facility may be released for unrestricted use.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
