On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your May 14, 2012, letter to the Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act Officer where you are appealing the agency's April 12, 2012, decision regarding your December 1, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request [FOIA-2012-0073], for a number of documents involving Halliburton Energy Services' Duncan, Oklahoma site. Specifically, you are appealing the redacting of possession limits for certain byproducts; certain information regarding the calibration of instruments, and sensitivity range information under FOIA Exemptions 4 and 7(F). Also, redacting in their entirety, pages 27 and 28 of record C-3, and the numbered page 28 of record C-4 under FOIA Exemption 4.

In response to your appeal, the NRC staff completed another review of the redactions applied and determined possession limits for certain byproducts; certain information regarding the calibration of instruments, and sensitivity range information can be released. Also, the information redacted on pages 27 and 28 of record C-3, and the numbered page 28 of record C-4 is now being released in its entirety. Therefore, I am granting your appeal, and unredacted versions of the records are enclosed.
