My parents were stationed in Kure, Japan in 1948. I was born 6 months after they arrived back in the US at Ft. Eustis, VA (1952). I have suffered with epilepsy since 1966-I no longer have seizures but have to deal with the side effects of the medication. Since 1984, I have been teaching in various DOD and public schools and businesses around the world (my husband is a retired West Point colonel). I am now having health problems that are a direct result of my mother's exposure to radiation while she was pregnant with me. I will have to quit work soon.

Is there any kind of disability I am eligible for? Is there any kind of government program for dependents of military personnel stationed in dangerous places?
